

Update for December 12, 2011 – 7 points of interest

1 – Recurrent Ground (RG) 2012 has several changes. For 2012, DTW based flight attendants will attend recurrent training in DTW; CVG based flight attendants will attend training in CVG. The 2012 training will consist of 8 hours classroom training and 5 hours computer based training (CBT). As noted in the January 2012 bid packet, **it is now required for all flight attendants to complete your CBT training at least 72 hours prior to the beginning of your classroom training date.** This new deadline is due to the Delta LMS System which updates the company with completed training statistics every 48 hours. Please review the details in your current Bid Packet.

2 – Negotiations will be held December 13 – 15. Committee members are working hard on your behalf to achieve a fair and equitable contract for **all** members. We are very excited about several suggestions submitted by flight attendants who are thinking outside the box to improve quality of life for the group.
